Get a few volunteers to stand up and complain about all the things they don't have. They should be dramatic and try to make the class feel sorry for them.

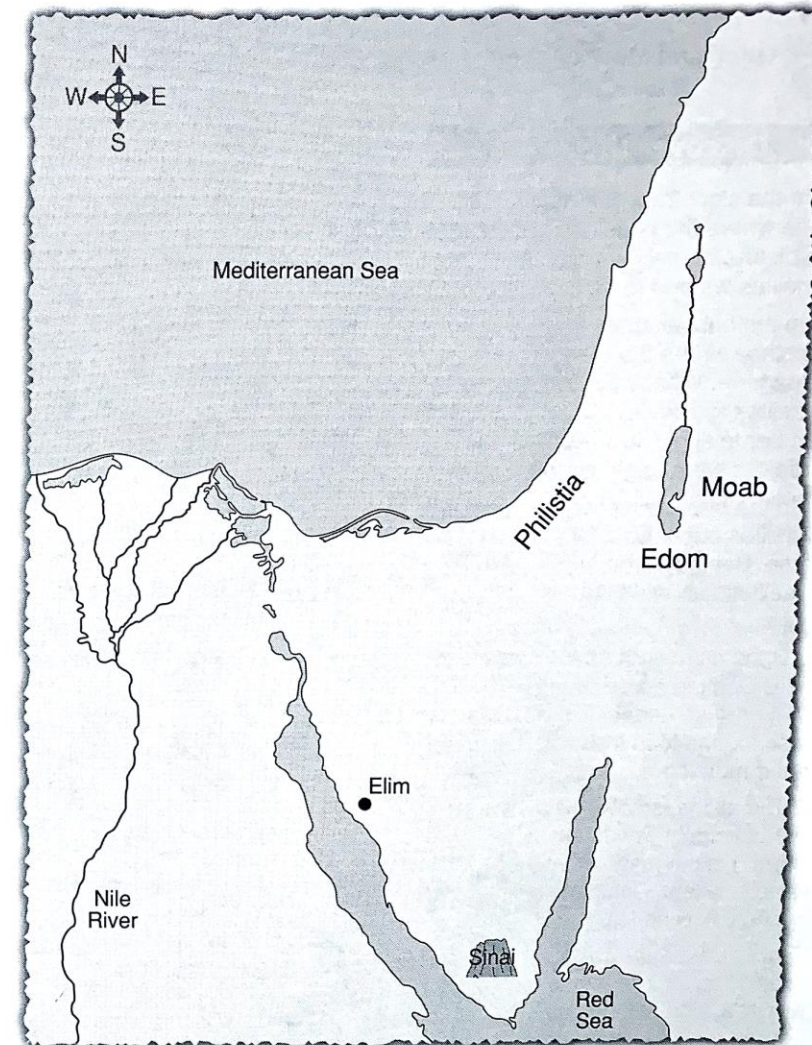
When the contestants have finished complaining, vote to see who is the winner.

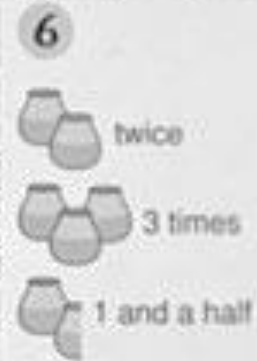
