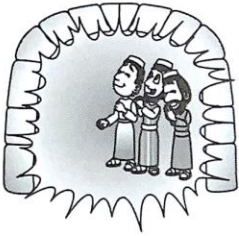

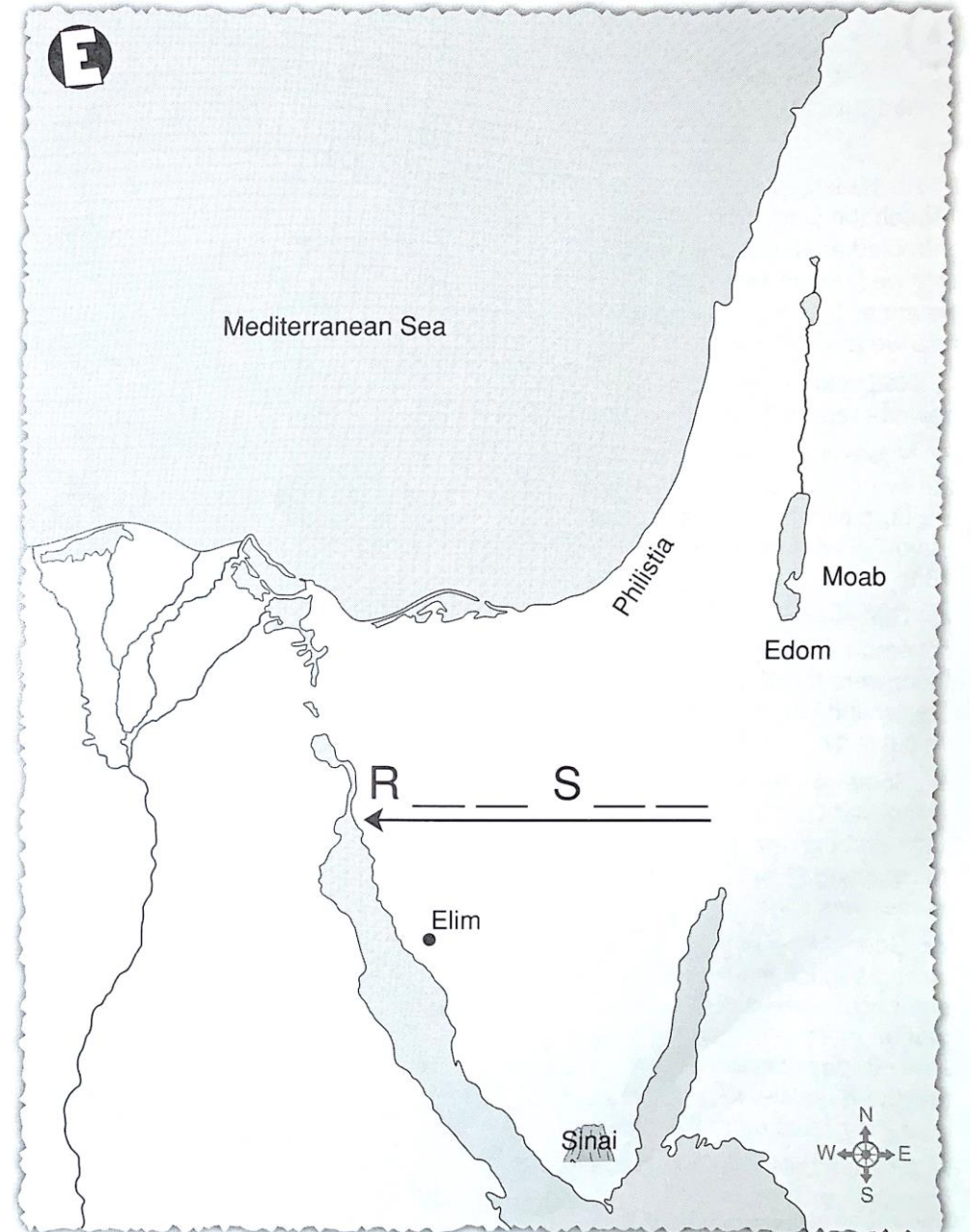

## Exodus 16

## God Gives Quail and Manna

1. As the Israelites traveled through the Desert of Sin, they grumbled against Moses saying, "If only we had died in Egypt! There we ate all the food we wanted, but now we are starving to death!"
2. God said to Moses, "I will rain down bread from heaven for you."
3. Moses said to the Israelites, "In the evening, you will know it was the Lord who brought you out of Egypt." Find and read Exodus 16:8.
4. That evening quail came and covered the camp. In the morning, there were thin flakes like frost on the ground. The Israelites asked, "What is it?"
5. Some of the Israelites disobeyed God and kept manna until the next day. The manna was full of maggots and smelled bad. Moses was angry!
6. God told the Israelites to gather twice as much manna on the sixth day because he would not send manna on the seventh day. The seventh day was the Sabbath. God told the Israelites to rest and stay near their tents on the Sabbath.
7. The Israelites called the bread from the Lord "manna."

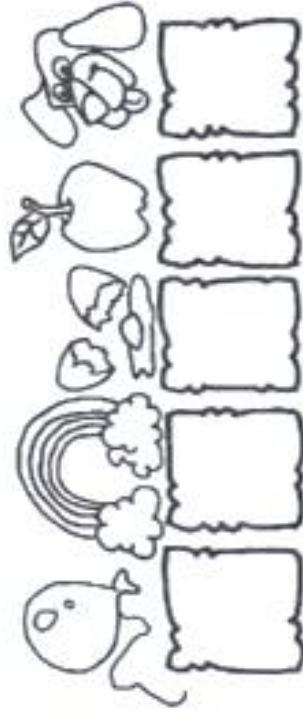

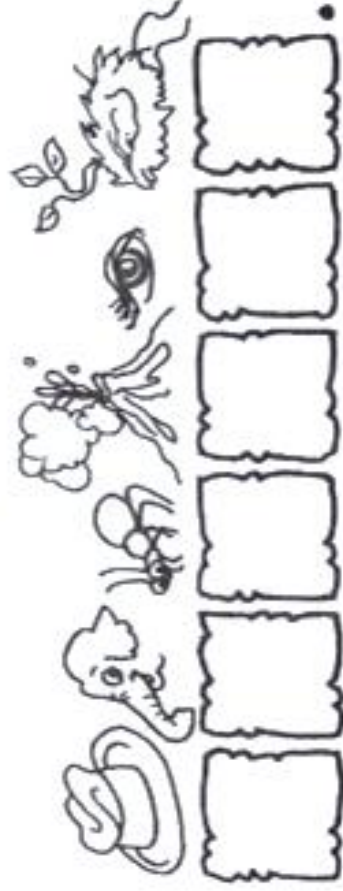
