

### **Get Active**

Turn two styrofoam cups upside down and draw a happy face on one cup and a sad face on the other cup. Ask: Why does God want us to obey him? Place your hands inside the cups and hold them up for the children to see. Ask: Is God happy or sad when we obey him? Say: Point to the face that shows how God feels when we obey him.

Give each child a small cup and have them draw a happy face on it. Say: I want you to place the cup on your hand and share a way you will obey God and make him happy this week. Allow the children time to share their ideas. Tell the children they may take their cups after class and share with their parents what they will do to obey God and make him happy this week.

Today in our Bible story, we will learn about people who said they would obey God.

# Apply It! Exodus 19:8 on obeying God



# Discover the Bible

- It took the Israelites about a month and a half to travel from Egypt to Mount Sinai. Color the mountain brown. Moses went up the mountain and God spoke to him. God said, "Even though everything is mine, the Israelites will be my special people if they obey me."
- Moses went back down the mountain and told the Israelites that they must obey God. The Israelites said, "Yes, we will obey God and do everything he says!" Circle the word "Yes."
- 3. Moses told the people that God was going to come to speak to them from Mount Sinai. He told the people to wash their clothes and be ready by the third day. Color the clothes blue. No one could touch Mount Sinai or they would die! Draw an X on the man touching Mount Sinai.
- 4. On the third day, a huge cloud with thunder and lightning covered Mount Sinai. Color the cloud black and the lightning yellow. The Israelites heard a loud trumpet blast. Everyone was scared and started to shake. Circle the frightened Israelites. Why do you think they were afraid? Moses climbed up the mountain to talk to God. How do you talk to God?

# 3-D Mount Sinai

### Supplies

- · copy of the 3-D Mount Sinai for each child
- · crayons or markers
- scissors
- · glue or double-sided tape


#### Directions

Color the four scenes, then cut out the pyramid around the solid lines only (do not cut on the dotted lines). Using glue or double-sided tape, assemble the pyramid by folding along the dotted lines (see the example). Use the 3-D Mount Sinai to retell the story of God giving ten rules to His people.



One day Moses went up Mount Sinai. God talked to him here. Moses was in the mountain for many days.

Color the path that will take Moses up to the top of the mountain.

# **Commandments Puzzle**

### Supplies

# Directions

Help children color the scenes in each puzzle piece and cut out the puzzle pieces individually. Children can assemble the puzzle and use it to tell about how God gave 10 rules to His people.

- 1) God wanted His people to obey Him.
- 2) God called Moses up on a mountain.
- 3) God gave 10 rules to Moses on stone tablets.
  4) Moses brought the rules back down the mountain to the people.
