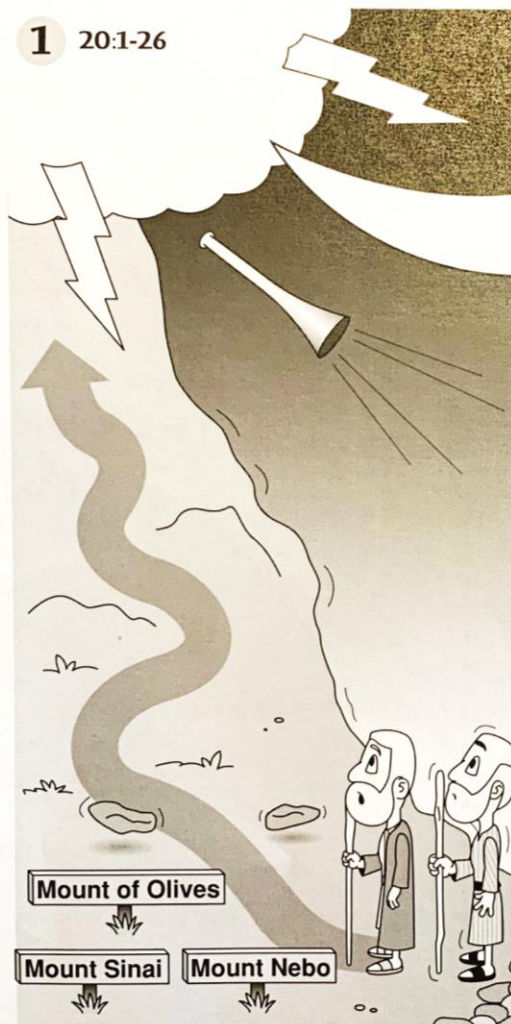
Exodus 20
God Gives Moses the Law

1. God came down upon Mount Sinai in a huge cloud with thunder and lightning. The Israelites heard a loud trumpet blast. All the Israelites trembled with fear! Moses led the Israelites close to the mountain to meet with God. Mount Sinai was covered with smoke, because the Lord came down on it in fire. The whole mountain trembled and the trumpet blast grew louder and louder!

2. Moses and Aaron went up Mount Sinai to listen to God. God said, "I am the Lord your God who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery." Then the Lord spoke each of the Ten Commandments.


