



Name

- 1. After Moses died, God told Joshua, "Get the Israelites ready to cross the Jordan River into the land of Canaan. I will give you every place where you set your foot. I will be with you just as I was with Moses."
- 2. God said to Joshua, "Be strong and courageous, because you will lead the Israelites into the promised land. Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law of Moses. Do not turn from it, to the right or to the left."
- 3. Find and read Joshua 1:8.
- 4. Joshua ordered his officers, "Go tell the people, 'Get your supplies ready. Three days from now you will cross the Jordan River into the land the Lord has given you."
- 5. The tribes of Reuben, Gad and half of Manasseh had already been given land on the east side of the Jordan River. Joshua told the men in these tribes to leave their families and their animals and cross over the Jordan River with the rest of the Israelites. Joshua told them to be ready to fight. The three tribes said, "We will obey."


