

#### Spies in Jericho Joshua 2

#### **Discover the Bible**

- Who was the leader of the Israelites after Moses died? Circle him. Joshua sent two spies to Jericho in the land of Canaan.
  When the spies came to the city, they went to the house of a woman named Rahab.
  Color Rahab's house.
- 2. The king of Jericho was told, "Look! Some Israelite men have come here to spy out the land!" With purple, color the king.
- 3. Rahab hid the spies under some plants called flax on the top of her roof. Color the flax orange. Some of the king's men came looking for the spies. Rahab said to the king's men, "Yes, the men came to me, but they have already left Jericho."
- 4. Rahab went to the roof to talk to the spies. She said to them, "All the people are afraid of you because they know that God has given you the land of Canaan." Color the "God" cloud yellow. Rahab said, "We have heard about how God led you out of Egypt and across the Red Sea, and how God helps you win your battles." Circle the Israelites crossing the Red Sea. Rahab said, "Since I have helped you, please show kindness to me and my family by letting us live."
- 5. Rahab let the spies down with a red rope through her window. The spies told Rahab, "You and your family will be safe if you tie this red rope in your window and stay inside your house." Color the rope red.
- 6. Rahab told the spies to hide in the hills for three days so the king's men would not find them. Behind the spies, draw hills.
- 7. The spies told Joshua everything that happened. "God has given us the land!" they said. "The people in Canaan are scared of us!" Circle the name of the one who would give the Israelites the land of Canaan.

#### **Get Active**

Bring with you enough prizes for every child, two poster-size pieces of paper cut in a circle and large, paper smiling face parts (eyes, nose, mouth) for each circle. Place tape on the back of the smiling face parts so they can be attached to the circle.

Divide into two teams. Have each team form a line on one side of the room. At the far end of the room, have the smiling face parts in two stacks, one for each team. Place a paper circle on the wall by each team. One child from each team will race to the other side of the room on their knees. They will choose a smiling face piece, then come back to their team and put the piece in the correct part of the circle. Then they will tag the next teammate in line and that student will do the same thing until their smiling face is completed. When the race is over, congratulate both teams.

Say: Now I am going to award prizes to the winners. Give each child a prize. All of you are winners because you listened and obeyed. Today we will learn that God's people are winners. If you listen to God and obey him, you are a winner!


