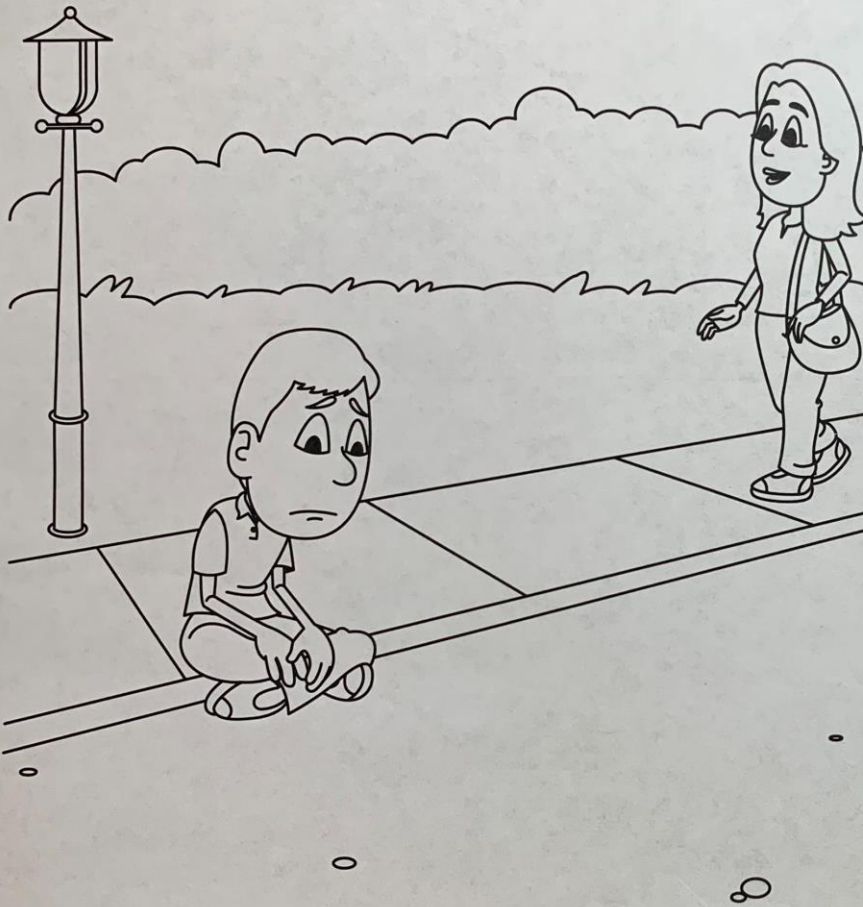

## Get Active

Have the students form a line behind you and hold on to a rope or a long piece of yarn. Lead the students around the room, weaving through chairs and other obstacles.

As you walk toward your goal (a destination known only by you), stop along the way and ask your students: **Who is leading you right now? Where are we going?** Begin walking again around the classroom. After a short time, stop and ask: **As we grow up, who helps us know where to go?** (parents, teachers, God) **We must let God lead us and he will show us where to go.**

Arrive at your goal. Say: **We made it! If we let God lead us, we will make it to our greatest goal, which is to be with God in Heaven!**

Today in our Bible story, we will see how God helped his people know where to go.

## Lesson 70

### Joshua 2 Spies in Jericho

Joshua sent two spies to look over the land, especially the city of Jericho. The spies went to Jericho and entered Rahab's house.

The king of Jericho heard that Israelite spies were in his city!

Rahab hid the spies under stalks of flax on her roof. The king of Jericho sent men to get the spies, but Rahab said, "The men have already left. Go after them quickly!"

Read what Rahab said to the spies when she went up on the roof in Joshua 2:9.

Rahab let the spies down by a red rope through the window. The spies told Rahab, "You and your family will only be saved if you tie this rope in your window. You must also bring your whole family into your house."

The two spies hid in the hills for three days until the men who were searching for them returned back to Jericho.

The spies went back to Joshua and said, "The Lord has surely given the whole land into our hands. All the people are melting in fear because of us."
