

#### **Get Active**

Have the students form a line behind you and hold on to a rope or a long piece of yarn. Lead the students around the room, weaving through chairs and other obstacles.

As you walk toward your goal (a destination known only by you), stop along the way and ask your students: Who is leading you right now? Where are we going? Begin walking again around the classroom. After a short time, stop and ask: As we grow up, who helps us know where to go? (parents, teachers, God) We must let God lead us and he will show us where to go.

Arrive at your goal. Say: We made it! If we let God lead us, we will make it to our greatest goal, which is to be with God in Heaven!

Today in our Bible story, we will see how God helped his people know where to go.


## Joshua 2 Spies in Jericho


Joshua sent two spies to anaan to look over the land, specially the city of Jericho. The pies went to Jericho and entered ahab's house.


