Get Active

Bring a dirty dish and a drawing of a fish with a frown.

Say: Keeping your promise means doing what you say you will do. What would happen if you promised to wash the dishes, but you didn't keep your promise? After they share answers, show them the dirty plate. Say: The dishes would still be dirty! What would happen if you did keep your promise? Wipe the plate with a wet wipe to show a clean plate. What if you promised to feed the fish, but you didn't keep your promise? After they share answers, show them a fish with a sad face. Say: The fish wouldn't be able to live if it wasn't fed! What if you did keep your promise? Place a smile over the frown on the fish.

Say: God wants us to keep our promises. Today in our Bible story, we will learn about people who kept their promise.

Apply It! Exodus 13:19 on keeping promises

Larry (holding football) borrowed Kenneth's football and said he would give it back. What is Larry doing now? Did Larry keep his promise? In the Bible story, who kept their promise? What promise did they keep? Talk about a time when you kept a promise. Ask God to help you do what you say you will do.

God Leads the Israelites Exodus 13

Discover the Bible

- 1. As the Israelites were leaving Egypt, God told Moses that every Israelite firstborn boy and animal belonged to him. With yellow, trace the arrows from the firstborn boy and animal to God.
- 2. Moses said to the people, "Remember this day, the day you came out of Egypt. God used his powerful hand to free us from being slaves!" Color the hand.
- 3. Later on, when the Israelite children asked their parents, "What does the Passover Feast mean?" God wanted the parents to tell their children how God led them out of Egypt. Color the Israelite father talking to his son.
- 4. Many years before, Joseph asked his brothers to promise that when they left Egypt and went back to Canaan, they would take his bones and bury them in Canaan. The Israelites kept their promise and took Joseph's bones with them when they left Egypt. Color the box brown.
- 5. God led the Israelites out of Egypt. In the daytime, God led the Israelites with a tall cloud in the sky. Color the cloud blue. At night, God led the Israelites with a big fire in the sky. Color the fire orange.
