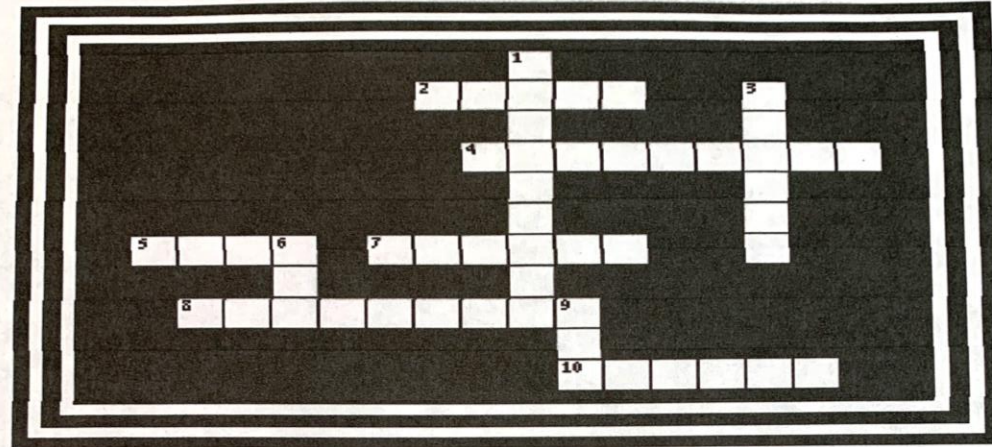

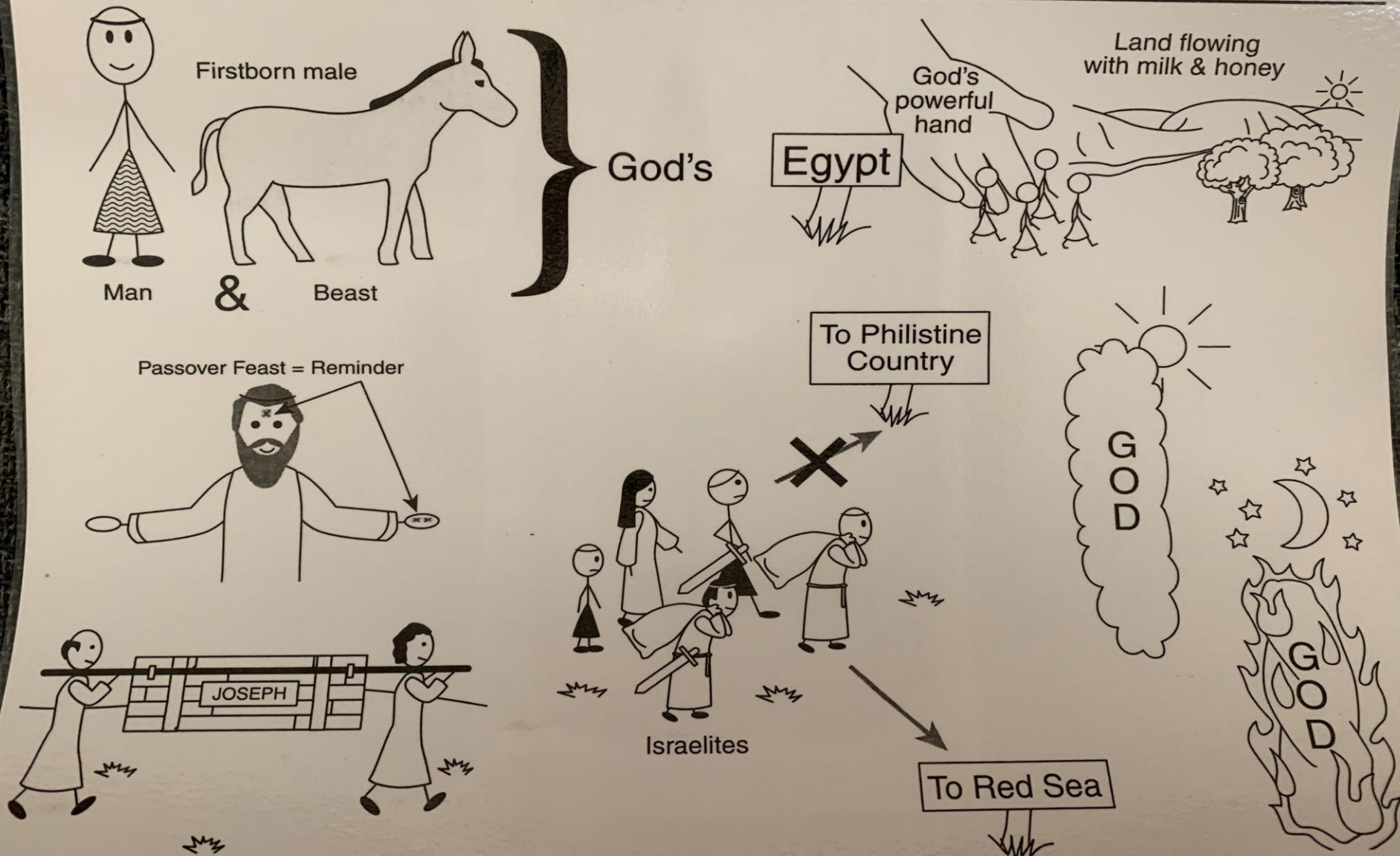

## 40. CROSSING THE RED SEA (EXODUS 14)

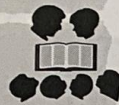


- 1 DOWN "The LORD is my strength and song, and He has become my \_\_\_\_." **EXODUS 15:2**

- 8 ACROSS "And the \_\_\_\_ pursued and went after them into the midst of the sea, all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen." **EXODUS 14:23**
- 4 ACROSS Then "Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and when morning appeared, the sea returned to its full depth, while the Egyptians were fleeing into it. So the LORD \_\_\_\_ the Egyptians in the midst of the sea." **EXODUS 14:27**
- 3 DOWN "Thus \_\_\_\_ saw the great work which the LORD had done in Egypt; so the people feared the LORD, and believed the LORD and His servant Moses." **EXODUS 14:31**

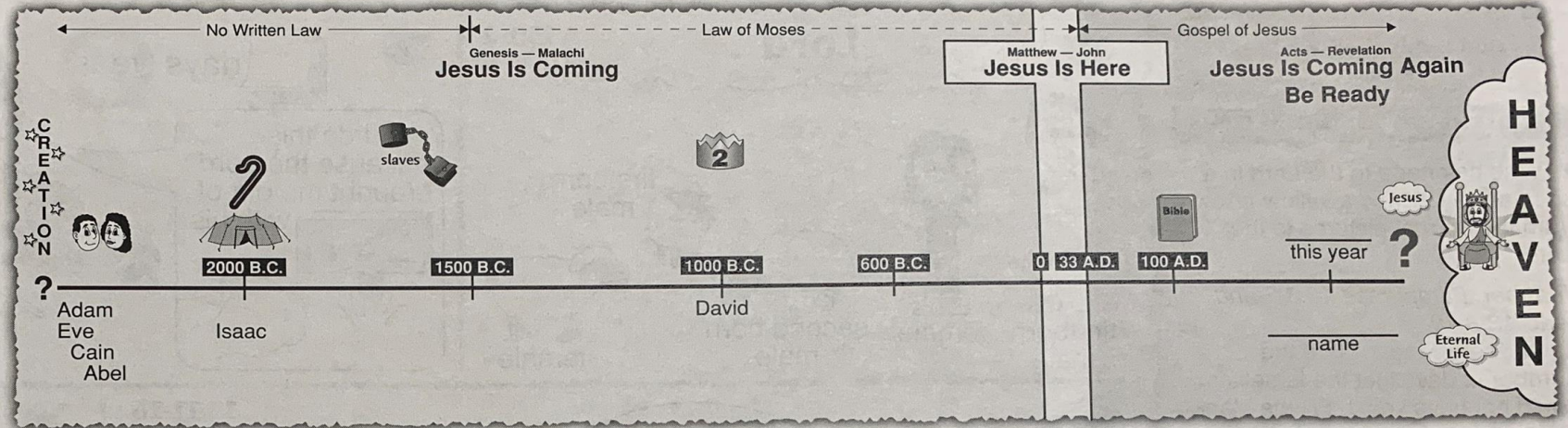
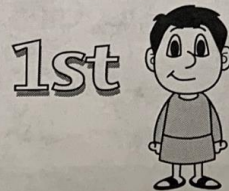

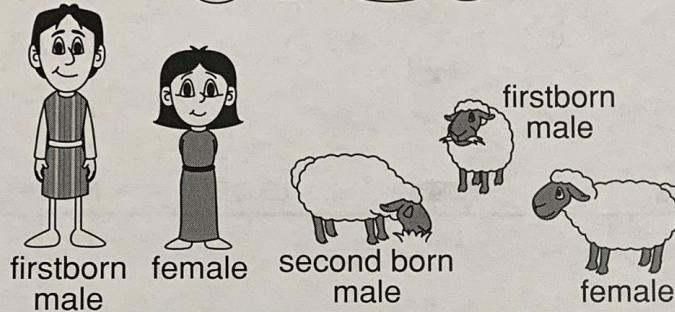
3. Circle the house where the firstborn son died. Why did God want the fathers to tell their children about him?

6. Who showed the Israelites which way to go? With red, color the way the Israelites were led at night.

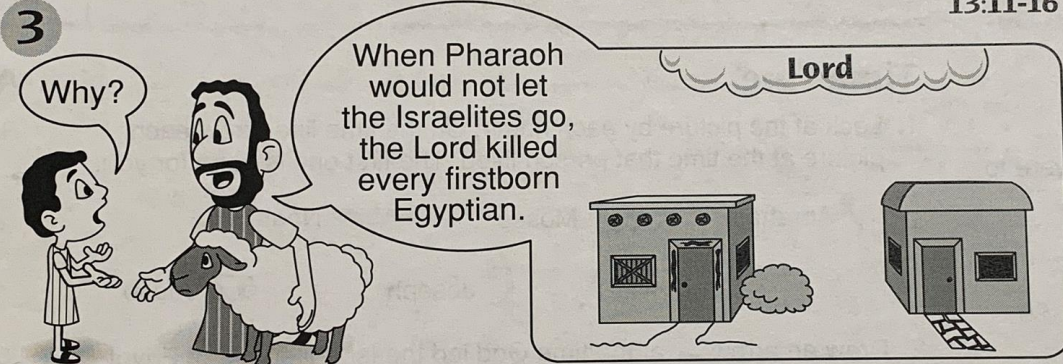
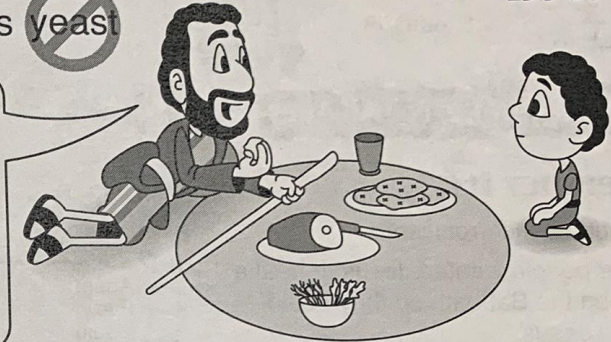
