




Quail and Manna Given Exodus 16

Discover the Bible

- 1. The Israelites were hungry while they were traveling. They started complaining to Moses. "We wish we were back in Egypt where we had plenty to eat!" they said. With brown, circle the complaining Israelites.
- 2. God heard the Israelites' complaining. He sent birds called quail for them to eat in the evening. Color the quail. Every morning, God sent bread on the ground for them to pick up and eat. The Israelites called the bread "manna." Find the manna. God told the Israelites to pick up only what they needed each day and not keep any for the next day.
- 3. Some of the Israelites disobeyed God and kept manna until the next day anyway. The manna smelled bad and had worms in it! Draw a circle around the stinky manna.
- 4. God told the Israelites to pick up twice as much manna on the sixth day because he would not send manna for them to pick up on the seventh day. Circle the two pots of manna. God told the Israelites to stay near their tents and rest on the seventh day. Color the 7 on the tent brown. Some Israelites did not obey God. They looked for manna on the seventh day anyway. Did they find any manna? Draw an X on the man looking for manna.
- 5. God told the Israelites to save a jar of manna so they could show it to their children. God wanted their children to see the manna and remember how God took care of the Israelites by feeding them in the desert! Color the jar of manna.
