Moses On The Mountain

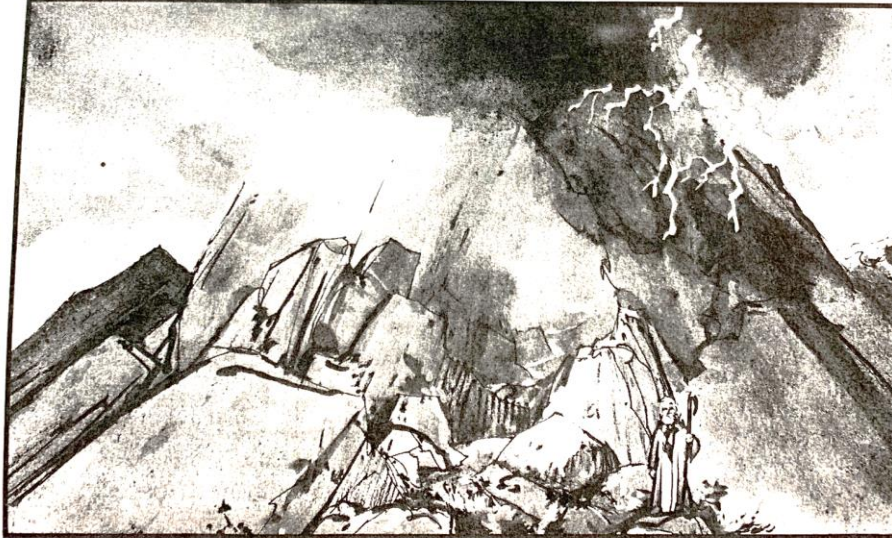
Exodus 19,20,24,31:18

The Israelites had seen God's power many times. They had been saved from the Egyptians, led across the Red Sea, given quails and manna to eat, and given water to drink.

They had never seen anything as powerful as what they saw at Mt. Sinai though! Here, the Israelites saw a huge mountain shake and smoke as if it was on fire. They saw lightning and a big black cloud at the top of the mountain. They heard a loud sound that was like a trumpet blowing. There, along with all of those frightening things, they heard the voice of God. God had actually come down on the top of the mountain.

All of the Israelites were afraid. They knew that God was there, but they did not understand what was happening. They were afraid that they were all going to die.

God did give the Israelites a law at this time and He told them that He would be with them and make them His special people, if they would love Him and obey His laws.

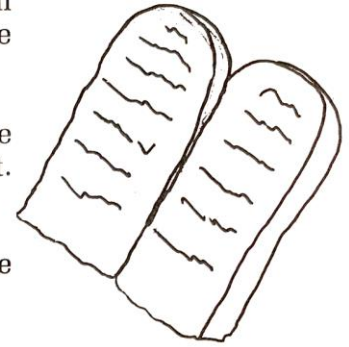
