






- 1. The Israelites traveled all the way from Egypt to Mount Sinai. Moses went up on Mount Sinai and God said, "Tell the Israelites these words: 'The whole world belongs to me, but if you obey me, you will be my special people. You will be a holy nation for me."
- Moses went back and told the Israelites all the Lord had commanded. Find and read Exodus 19:8.
- 3. Moses told the people, "In three days, you will see God come down on Mount Sinai! Everyone must wash their clothes to prepare for the third day. No one must touch the mountain or they will be put to death!"
- 4. On the third day, God came down on Mount Sinai in a huge, dark cloud with thunder and lightning. The Israelites heard a loud trumpet blast. All the people trembled with fear! Moses led the Israelites close to the mountain to meet with God. Mount Sinai was covered with smoke because the Lord came down on it in fire. The whole mountain trembled and the trumpet blast grew louder and louder!

- · crayons or markers
- scissors
- · glue or double-sided tape


Directions

Color the four scenes, then cut out the pyramid around the solid lines only (do not cut on the dotted lines). Using glue or double-sided tape, assemble the pyramid by folding along the dotted lines (see the example). Use the 3-D Mount Sinai to retell the story of God giving ten rules to His people.
