Guess What...

The **Levites** are descendants of Levi, one of Jacob's twelve sons. The Levites took care of the tabernacle, the tent-like place of worship before the temple was built.

The **ark of the covenant** was a gold-covered box with winged, angel-like creatures called cherubim on its lid. God met with Moses between the cherubim (Ex 25:10-22) and gave Moses his commands.



- In the Bible story, how did the Israelites know where to go?






1. With blue, draw waves beneath the name of the river the Israelites were going to cross.


