




Moses at the Red Sea






Exodus 13 God Leads the Israelites

- God told Moses, "Every firstborn son and firstborn male animal belongs to me."
- 2. Moses said to the Israelites, "When God brings you into the land of Canaan, you must celebrate the Passover each year and remember the day that God brought you out of Egypt. You must eat unleavened bread for seven days and tell your children, 'I do this because of what the Lord did for me when he brought me out of Egypt with his mighty hand!"
- 3. Moses also said, "When your children ask why the firstborn sons and animals belong to God, tell them, 'When Pharaoh would not let us go, God killed every firstborn son in Egypt. That is why every firstborn belongs to God in a special way."
- 4. When Pharaoh let the Israelites go, God led them out of Egypt toward the Red Sea.
- 5. Find and read Exodus 13:19.
- 6. The Israelites left Succoth and camped at Etham. In the daytime, God led the Israelites in a pillar of cloud. At night, God guided the Israelites in a pillar of fire.
