# THE PROMISE OF MESSIAH: WHAT THE BIBLE

1. Deuteronomy 18:15-18 | The Messiah would be a prophet like Moses.
2. 1Samuel 16:12-16 | The Messiah would be a King from the Davidic Dynasty within the house of Jesse (2Samuel 7:12-16; 23:1-7).
3. Psalm 100:4 | The Messiah would be a Priest from the order of Melchizedek.

Note that the passing of time here (*at its minimum*) is 500 years: One revelation averaging every 160 years.

12/9 Lesson 1 A Revelation of Firsts

Before the Prophets Began Writing, God was already

speaking about the Messiah's **Purpose**:

1. **Genesis 3:15** | Where sin, the serpent, and the Seed are introduced to humanity as God's solution.
2. **Genesis 12:3** | Where the Seed is introduced as an heir within a human family: Abraham.
3. **Genesis 49:10** | Where the Seed is introduced as a descendent of a particular tribe.

Note that the passing of time (*at its minimum here*) is 2200 years: One revelation averaged every 700 years.

# THE PROMISE OF MESSIAH: WHAT THE BIBLE REVEALS

As the Prophets Began Writing, God began to specify more, but about the Messiah's **Position**:

- 1. Deuteronomy 18:15-18** | The Messiah would be a prophet like Moses.
- 2. 1Samuel 16:12-16** | The Messiah would be a King from the Davidic Dynasty within the house of Jesse (2Samuel 7:12-16; 23:1-7).
- 3. Psalm 100:4** | The Messiah would be a Priest from the order of Melchizedek.

Note that the passing of time here (*at its minimum*) is 500 years: One revelation averaging every 160 years.

# THE PROMISE OF MESSIAH: WHAT THE BIBLE REVEALS

As the Prophets Began Writing, God began to specify more, but about the Messiah's **Destiny**:

- 1. Psalm 2** | The Messiah would be rejected and exalted.
- 2. Psalm 22** | The Messiah would die a violent death.
- 3. Psalm 16** | The Messiah would not be abandoned to Hades.

Note that the passing of time here (*at its minimum*) is one generation.

# THE PROMISE OF MESSIAH: WHAT THE BIBLE REVEALS

As the Prophets Began Writing, God began to specify more, but about the Messiah's **Work**:

- 1. Joel 2:28-32 | 830 BC |** Because of Peter's words in Acts 2, we know the Messiah would send the Spirit.
- 2. Amos 9:9-15 | 755 BC |** Because of James' words in Acts 15:13-18, we know the Messiah would rebuild the house of David for all people.
- 3. Isaiah 9:1-7; 53 | 740-700 BC |** Messiah would be seed of Yahweh and David (Romans 1:3) and would suffer and bear the sins for everyone and bring glory to Zion.

Note the passing of time here is 130 years.
